Recommended Substrate Conditions & Preparation

Surfaces are to be suitably prepared in accordance with proper trade practices.

Ensure the surface is clean, dry and free from dust, dirt and grease. All loose, peeling or flaking material must be removed. Fill holes and cracks with a suitable filler and sand lightly to an even finish.

Paper-faced plasterboard: Ensure that the boards have been installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and that all joints are prepared to a smooth, level finish, free of tool marks and ridges; and that the boards are finished to the specified level. Do not sand the uncoated paper-faced plasterboard.

Timber: Ensure the surface is clean and dry. Fill any holes, cracks or surface imperfections with a suitable filler, referring to the manufacturer's instructions regarding priming if required before application of the filler. Sand thoroughly in the direction of the timber grain before wiping down to remove sanding dust.

If mould is present, clean surface with household bleach then rinse well with clean water.

Application Guide

Stir paint thoroughly with a flat stirrer until contents are uniform and thoroughly mixed.

This product is recommended for airless spray application only.

Apply to a properly prepared surface as cross hatch applications wet on wet.

Suggested spray settings for paper-faced plasterboard: 5-21 thou tip at 3000psi.

Suggested spray settings for timber: 3-13 thou tip at 3000psi. (These settings will reduce texture which will cut down on sanding).

Application is by trained applicators only, for further advice contact your Wattyl representative.

For walls and areas other than ceilings apply appropriate Wattyl coatings as the finish coats by brush, roller, or spray. Do not apply when temperature is below 10°C or above 35°C or when humidity is very high.

New paper-faced plasterboard	Apply cross hatch applications wet-on-wet of Wattyl Ultra Prep+Ceiling Surface Pro Flat.
Bare timber and MDF	Apply cross hatch applications wet-on-wet of Wattyl Ultra Prep+Ceiling Surface Pro Flat. On tannin rich timbers first apply one coat of Wattyl Ultra Prep Primer Sealer Undercoat.
