



Which sheen level is the best for your project?



Matt

Matt paint has the lowest light reflection, helps to hide imperfections and is best used in low traffic areas. As this sheen helps to absorb more light, colours will look slightly darker than when painted in a higher sheen level. This sheen helps to counteract the effect of glare in spaces with a lot of natural light.



Low Sheen

Low Sheen paint has a low-reflective finish that has a slight sheen, which hides imperfections and has great cleanability, making it perfect for high traffic areas. Also recommended for ceilings in wet areas such as bathrooms and laundries.



Satin (Semi Gloss)

Satin paint has a slightly glossy appearance with extra durability and washability. Satin sheen is suitable for all interior surfaces including walls, doors, wood trim and cabinetry.



Gloss

Gloss paint is highly reflective and easy to clean, but can show up imperfections. It is perfect for doors and wood trim.

Tips & Hints



Sample Pots

Please purchase a sample pot to test your colour at home. Look at your testing sample at different times of the day and with the lights on and off, as light and the surroundings impact how colours appear.



LRV

LRV (Light Reflectance Value) refers to the proportion of light a paint color reflects. The higher the LRV, the more light the colour will reflect.



Colour & Contrast

To bring interest to a neutral colour scheme, introduce accent colours and tonal contrast with furniture, accessories, rugs and art.
